

## **Guidelines for Reviewers**

European Policy Analysis (EPA) is a double-blind peer-reviewed journal on policy research with the aim of presenting the European perspective(s) on policy analysis. It is interested in publishing papers that represent a significant contribution to knowledge. Papers should be literate, should demonstrate a good understanding of the relevant literature, and should contain at least one of the following:

- a new theoretical result,
- on empirical basis a new interpretation of received theory,
- new empirical findings, which are of interest to other scholars,
- well argued criticism or evaluation of the work of others.

Please send – in English, French or German – your written comments, which will be sent anonymously to the author/authors. If a paper is not good enough, please say so and provide a minimal set of conditions sufficient for rejection. In all other cases, any helpful comments to improve the paper will be greatly appreciated by the author/authors and the editors. Please close your comments with a clear judgment whether or not the piece merits publication in the European Policy Analysis using the EPA review form.
